#### **GENERAL GUIDELINES**

- 1. The Satyan Carnival is open to all children in the category of classes IV- XII.
- 2. All the events will be divided into three categories:

Category A: IV-V

Category B: VI-VIII

Category C: IX-XII

- 3. The carnival will be held for three days: 8<sup>th</sup> May, 2014 10<sup>th</sup> May, 2014.
- 4. Registration forms for all the events should be emailed positively by 28<sup>th</sup> April, 2014 at spm\_school2004@yahoo.com
- 5. Kindly send the list of the names of the participants according to the prescribed format attached with the Invitation letter.
- 6. All teams shall be accompanied by maximum 2 teachers designated by the Principal of the participating school.
- 7. The participating team should carry a covering letter, signed by the Principal, approving the date of birth of the students.
- 8. Students are required to come with their I-cards/ Age proofs duly attested by the School Principal. It is the school's responsibility to ensure confirmation with rules and regulations regarding age. Any discrepancy found later can lead to disqualification of the team. Kindly note that all students/teachers/maids should have I-cards. Members without I-cards will not be allowed inside the campus. There will be strict checking at the gate itself.

- 9. Any damage caused to the school property during the carnival by any participant will have to be borne by the team in charge of the respective participating school.
- 10. The decision of the judges will be final and binding.
- 11. The participants not adhering to the time limit, wherever applicable, shall be disqualified.
- 12. The Chairman, Organizing Committee shall reserve the right to take or change any decision for any reason not covered under the rules and regulations enumerated above.
- 13. The name of the winners will be declared on the last day of the carnival.
- 14. An overall trophy will be declared for the team bagging maximum prizes.

#### **RULES AND REGULATIONS**

# **English Story-telling Competition**

- 1. Only one student from each school may participate.
- 2. The time limit will be 3-4 minutes (including introduction).
- 3. The participant should speak the moral of the story in the end.
- 4. The participants will be adjudged on the basis of confidence, expression, fluency, intonation and voice modulation.

## **Website Designing**

- 1. One team of two students may participate.
- 2. The participants should work on the topic: Travel and Tourism.
- 3. The time limit for preparing the website is 2 hours.
- 4. Students can use HTML or Front Page for designing their website.
- 5. You may not use intellectual property (text, data, sound, or images) created by another person without obtaining written permission from its author/creator. The creator(s) and original source(s) must be listed on the References/Citation sheet, with written permission(s) attached.
- 6. The students can use picture, clipart, audio and video files provided by the host school. In case the students want to use softcopies of their own material for their Presentation then they need to submit their CDs four days before the competition in a folder titled with school name.
- 7. The students will be allowed to access the internet for searching the material for their presentation, if required.
- 8. The teams would be adjudged on the basis of content, structure and navigation, visual design, functionality, interactivity, and overall experience)

#### **Nukkad Natak**

- 1. Only one team comprising 6-8 students may participate from each school.
- 2. Only pre-recorded music is allowed.
- 3. For stage setting, the team will be provided with 2 chairs and 1 table by the host school.
- 4. The theme should be any social issue.
- 5. The act should be comical.
- 6. The students should enact the play in school uniform only.
- 7. The participants should maintain decorum and decency in words.
- 8. The time limit of the play should be 6 7 minutes.
- The criteria of judgement will be based on acting, dialogue delivery, theme, theatre etiquette and overall performance.

## **English Declamation Contest**

- 1. One student from each school may participate.
- 2. The time limit is 3 4 minutes.
- 3. The participants not adhering to the time limit shall stand disqualified.
- 4. The criteria of judgement will be done on the basis of clarity, content, pronunciation, body language and over all presentation.
- 5. Topics for the declamation are:
  - 1. Nature provides a free lunch, but only if we control our appetites
  - 2. In our quest for technological perfection, we are losing the human element.
  - 3. Victory is in the quality of competition and not the final score.

# **Extempore Competition in English**

- 1. One student from each school may participate
- 2. The participant will be allowed to prepare for one minute.
- The participant should speak for minimum one minute.
- 4. The criteria of judgement will be done on the basis of clarity, content, relevance, pronunciation, confidence and expression.

## **Comic Strip Making**

- 1. One team of two students from each school may participate.
- 2. Students will bring an A4 size sheet for their creation.
- Students must bring stationary, colours and other materials as per their requirement along with them.
- 4. Topics for the comic strip are:

- a. Human Rights.
- b. Fraternity.
- c. Global Diversity.
- 5. Students will be given theme on the spot from the topics given above.
- 6. The time limit will be 2 hours.
- 7. The students will be adjudged on the basis of clarity, creativity and relevance to the topic.

## **Book -mark making Competition**

- 1. Only one student from each school may participate.
- 2. Size of the book mark should be 10" x 4". MITTAL So
- 3. Accessories can be added to enhance overall effect.
- 4. Students should bring their own material including drawing boards and can use any medium.
- 5. The participants shall get two hours to complete the book mark.
- 6. Innovation, neatness, originality and overall presentation will be the parameters for judgement.

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# **Mono-acting Competition**

- 1. Only one entry from each school.
- 2. The time limit will be 3 to 4 minutes (including Introduction).
- 3. The act should be theme based and have some message.
- 4. The participant can perform in any language Hindi, English, Punjabi or all the three.
- 5. Act should not contain any indecent action or word.
- 6. The child will be judged on the basis of content, drama, voice modulation and confidence.

# **Group Song Competition**

- 1. Only one entry is allowed.
- 2. Number of participants in a group should be 4-6.
- 3. Accompanists playing instruments may be three.
- 4. The Group song should be in English only and it should be based on universal brotherhood.
- 5. Each team shall be allotted 5 minutes to set the instruments and mic.
- 6. The time allotted for singing is 3-4 minutes.
- 7. The team may use a track to sing.
- 8. The team will be judged on the basis of rhythm, melody, harmony and presentation.

# **Solo Song Competition**

- 1. Only one entry is allowed.
- 2. The song should be a Punjabi traditional Folk song.
- 3. Accompanists playing instruments may be three.
- 4. Propriety should be observed in lyrics.
- 5. Each participant shall be allotted 5 minutes to set the instrument and mic.
- 6. The time allotted for singing is 3 -5 minutes.
- 7. The participant will be judged on the basis of rhythm, melody, harmony and presentation.

#### Multimedia fiesta

- Only one entry per school is allowed. The student shall make a presentation using Ms- PowerPoint
   2010 on Windows 7.
- 2. The participant should work on the theme: **Eight Wonders of the World.**
- 3. The participant should prepare 12-15 slides. The presentation should include Title of the presentation, acknowledgement, bibliography, participant's Team Name.
- 4. Every participant shall be allotted two hours to prepare the PPT.
- 5. Video files if needed can be embedded. Participants cannot use more than two media/video files.
- 6. The students can use picture, clipart, audio and video files provided by the host school. In case the students want to use softcopies of their own material for their Presentation, it should be submitted in the CD two days before the competition in a folder titled with the school name.
- 7. The students will be allowed to access the internet for searching the material for their presentation, if required.
- 8. The PPT will be adjudged on the basis of creativity, application of knowledge (design, animation), relevance to the topic, accuracy and overall presentation.

# **Robotics Competition**

- 1. A school team should comprise of 2 students.
- 2. The time limit is 3 hours.
- 3. The control program must be written using the ROBOLAB or LEGO® MINDSTORMSTM Education NXT software.
- 4. Teams should prepare and bring all the equipment (software, portable computers, batteries, extension wires, etc.) that they need during the tournament. Teams should not use any flammable materials as part of their designs.
- 5. Teams should bring enough spare parts. In the event of accidents or equipment malfunction, the organisers are not responsible for any maintenance and replacement of equipment.

- 6. Mentors are not allowed to enter the quarantine area and give instructions or guidance to their teams during assembly time.
- 7. Teams are allowed to bring only one NXT/RCX controller into the quarantine area.
- 8. Batteries used during the competition can be 6 pieces of AA batteries or lithium batteries of LEGO© MINDSTORMSTM NXT. Other power supply devices which are not authorised by the organisers are not allowed.
- 9. All the parts for the robot should be in the initial states (not pre-built) before the assembling time. For example, a tire cannot be put on a wheel until the assembling time begins.
- 10. Contestants may not refer to any instruction sheets in any form including written, illustrated or pictorial.
- 11. Teams are allowed to pre-program the robot or store the program in the laptop before the competition.

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- 12. No screws, glues or tapes are to be used to fasten any components of the robot. Non-compliance with this rule will result in disqualification from the competition.
- 13. Modification of any original parts, for example, RCX Intelligent Brick, NXT Intelligent Brick, motors, sensors, etc. is not allowed. Violation of this rule will result in disqualification.
- 14. The judgement criteria will be programming, engineering, presentation and team spirit.

## Graffiti

- 1. Each team will be represented by 3 participants.
- 2. Participants will get their own material, brushes, paints and other things to give overall effect.
- 3. The theme of the graffiti: Nature At its Best.
- 4. The size of graffiti should be 3 x 3 feet.

- 5. The time limit is 2 hours.
- 6. The judgement will be done on the basis of creativity, relevance to the topic, originality and overall presentation.

# **Fireless Cooking**

- 1. Only one student from each school may participate.
- 2. Pre preparations which require any form of gas heating or cooking should be done from home.
- 3. Preparation and presentation of the dish to be done on the spot.
- 4. All materials is to be procured by the students only (including raw materials, crockery etc.)
- 5. The time limit is 1 hour.
- 6. The judgment will be done on the basis of taste, creativity, innovation and overall presentation.

#### **Group Dance**

- 1. One team from each school may participate comprising 6-8 students.
- 2. Only pre recorded music is allowed. The music should be on CD on mp3 format. The participating school should send two copies of CD with their entry form.
- 3. The participating teams are allowed to use props.
- 4. The theme for the same Cultural Diversity.
- 5. The time limit is 3-4 minutes.
- 6. Propriety should be observed in lyrics, costumes and steps.
- 7. The team will be judged on the basis of technique, coordination, enthusiasm, costumes and expressions.
