

A short Field Trip for Class VII to Hem Hosiery Works



In order to appraise students with various vocational skills and make them aware of the local opportunities available to them, Sat Paul Mittal School organized a field trip for the students of class VII to Hem Hosiery Works under the Vocational Education Program. About 55 students chaperoned by 4 teachers, spent more than an hour inspecting various machines and talking to the experts who explained the process involved in the making of yarn and then how it is woven into a fabric. Students learnt to differentiate between a natural fibre and synthetic fibre like acrylic. They thoroughly enjoyed exploring various facets of hosiery industry by asking questions to the experts who encouraged students by answering all their queries.
