

Visit to Cakes & Coffee for the students of Class III

the students of Class III. The initiative focuses on helping them acquire knowledge and competencies that they need to work proficiently and assist them in acquiring the specific C4 skillset, namely, Communication, Collaboration, Critical Thinking and Creativity to fully participate in today's global community.

The students were given a warm welcome and were apprised of the company profile. The students were made aware of the wide range of bakery products that the company manufactures from breads, cakes, cookies, pastries and many more. The children were briefed on the safety rules to be followed while being in the factory vicinity. They were made to wear aprons, baker's caps and gloves while moving through the different sections of the factory. The students were apprised of the various skills right from dough making to proofing, baking, icing and finally adding the artisanal element to the final product. A live workstation was also organised wherein the students were provided a cupcake, doughnut, icing cone and various decorative confetti. They enjoyed icing their own cakes and decorating them using their own creative ideas.

The learning objective of the visit was to encourage students to get hands-on experience in bakery section and also to familiarise with the baking process and utensils that are used in bakery and foresee a career in baking industry.
