

A Field Trip to GADVASU for the students of Class X, XI and XII Science



A field trip to GADVASU (Guru Angad Dev Veterinary and Animal Sciences University) was organized for the students of Class X, XI and XII Science. The objective is to help them explore what lies beyond their school years, to understand different field of veterinary as veterinary sciences, animal biotechnology, Fisheries and Dairy technology and to appreciate Veterinary science and its allied fields as a profession. They were also apprised about the eligibility conditions for admission to GADVASU.

At clinical wing of veterinary college, students observed the working at the OPD wing of medicine department. They were shown around the wards where the small animals were being treated as well the critical care unit. They saw how the animals are prepared before the operation.

At the college of Fisheries, the students were briefed on the farming of fishes and different types of practices for the same. They saw various ornamental fishes in aquarium at the Aquaculture wing and also at the wet lab. They had firsthand experience of observing how fishes are harvested in the pond and saw different varieties of fishes. The students were very excited and thrilled to see the fishes in the ponds.

At the school of Animal biotechnology they were shown around different labs where research on vaccines, DNA amplification. At the college of dairy technology, the students were briefed on milk production and distribution and the technology behind the optimization of the same.

The students were overwhelmed by the facilities available at the veterinary university, they learnt and appreciated the scope of veterinary sciences and its allied fields.
