Workshop- Bloom's Taxonomy by Ms. Roopali Suri



A workshop on Bloom's Taxonomy was conducted by Ms. Roopali Suri on 1st June 2019 at Sat Paul Mittal School.

For decades now, Bloom's Taxonomy has helped educators develop critical thinking and higher order cognitive abilities in students. The workshop began with an activity to incorporate cross- curricular connections between subjects. This activity helped the educators to understand the correct way of creating a lesson on cross- curricular connections.

A discussion was held to have a better clarity on goals, learning objectives and learning outcomes.

The resource person touched upon the three domains of Bloom's Taxonomy i.e. cognitive, affective and psychomotor.
