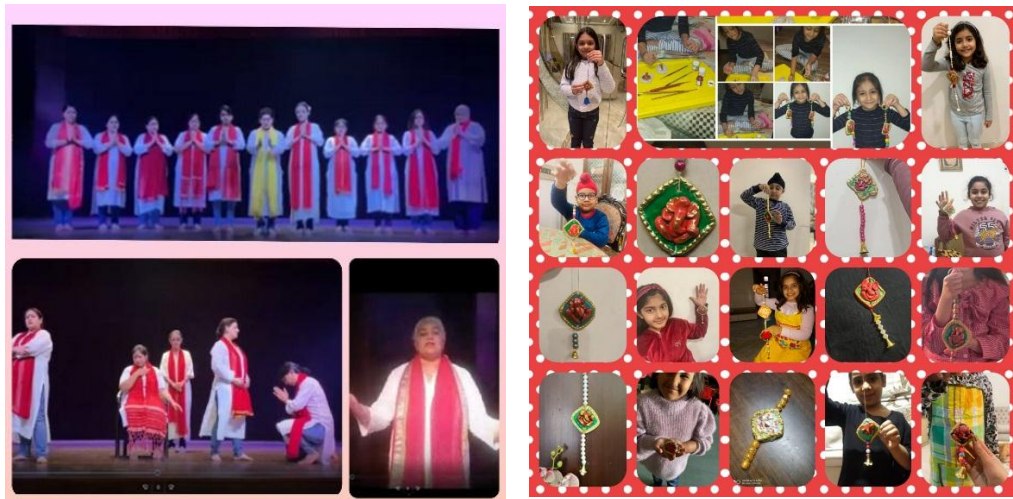


Sat Paul Mittal School organized 'Diwali Dhamaka' virtually
