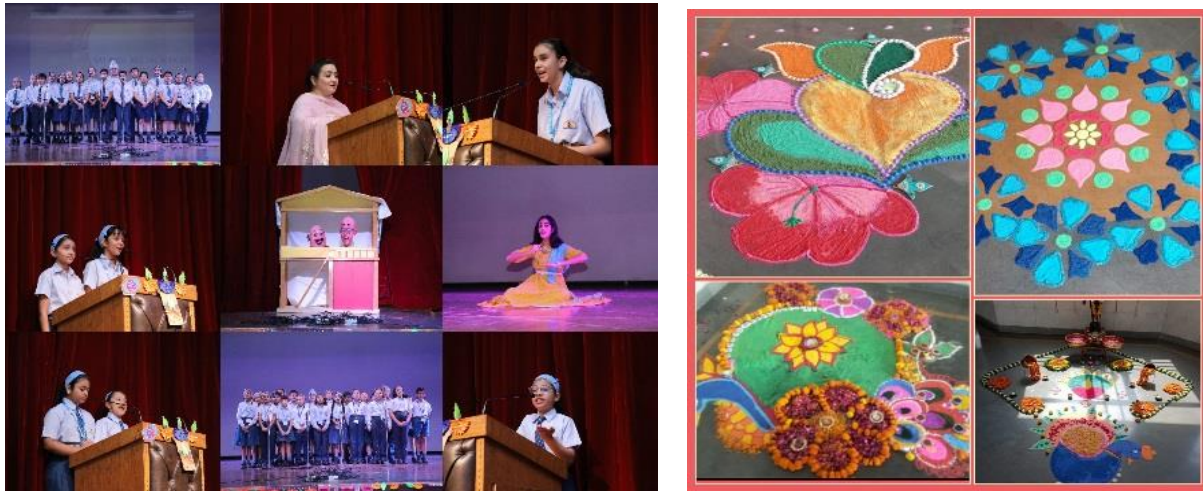


## 'Diwali-The Festival of Lights'
