

Grade XI - Visit to Plaksha University

A visit to the university campus is an important part of decision-making process. It provides beneficial information one cannot get from other sources. A campus tour of Plaksha University for the students of Grade XI was arranged at Sat Paul Mittal School, Ludhiana on 9th December, 2022. As a part of the College and Career Readiness Program, the main objective of the visit was to help Satyans make informed decisions about future careers while showcasing the infrastructure of the university as well.

Plaksha University aims to reimagine technology education and research for India and the world. It prepares students to create solutions that address complex problems of the modern world. The visit consisted of two major parts: a presentation about undergraduate programs followed by a tour of the Maker space and the campus, and a workshop on emerging technologies conducted by Prof. Ruchi and Prof. Prashant. The students were given a brief peek into the undergraduate programs offered by the university. They were told about product development and the different user demographics and then were asked to take their partners as users and design ‘an ideal wallet’ meeting their demands. This took their understanding of design-thinking and entrepreneurship to another level. Plaksha’s Maker space fosters an environment for interdisciplinary learning, innovation, and creativity. Students were also shown the working of 3D-printers and lasers in the Maker space. Mr. Rudra Pratap, the Vice-chancellor, addressed the students and gave them an insight into the futuristic courses offered and the life of an undergraduate student at Plaksha.
