





Workshop 1:

The day started with a workshop conducted by Mr. Ashutosh Mahajan, a Business Strategist and Board Member LPU, who served as a Maha Mentor for the delegates. In the workshop, the students were introduced to the concept of entrepreneurship and were given a run down on how to ensure that the startup becomes successful.

Mr. Ashutosh apprised all about the 5 key characteristics a young entrepreneur should have. He said that there's a lot of work that goes into getting a new venture off the ground and scaling a business for sure. While hard work is undoubtedly important, there is one thing that ensures whether any business will thrive or fail is its owner. More specifically, the qualities of the owner. He greatly emphasized that the proprietor needs to have a vision, should be a good listener, discipline oneself without force and stay resilient, a good leader and attain the equilibrium between studies and entrepreneurship.

Workshop 2:

Mr Sandeep Verma, Research Associate, Senior Member IEEE IIT Kharagpur acted as the mentor in the second Maha Mentor workshop along with Mr Lottie Mukuka, R&D (Head) AI Expert WHIZROBO. Mr Verma began the session by saying that 'Imagination is better than knowledge'. Imagination knows no boundaries and hence fosters creativity. Innovation is a means to push the boundaries of existing knowledge. Brainstorming was emphasized, with equal importance given to analysing the numerous possible solutions. He said that entrepreneurship is all about thinking outside the box. The entrepreur needs to find solutions to the problems and needs that people face and come up with ways of delivering these solutions through products and services. In order to find out which "goldmine" niches to approach, one has to think differently from the rest. He also impressed upon the need of team building and networking.

The workshop ended with Q&A session. Queries of the students were addressed and were given a clear understanding on how to put their plan into action.
